

Doug Plasencia, P.E., CFM- Doug is a specialist in floodplain and watershed management. His input on floodplain management policy and science has been requested by the National Academies of Sciences , Congress, and various federal agencies. He is the co-developer of the No Adverse Impact floodplain management strategy as well as was instrumental in integrating multi-objective planning strategies into floodplain management.
